

OAKLEIGH THORNE MAY RUN.

Trust Company President Said to
Want to Go to Congress.

POUGHKEEPSIE, N. Y., Sept. 2.—Oakleigh Thorne, President of the Trust Company of America, wants to run for Congress in the Twenty-first District on the Republican ticket next Fall. This is the report that has become current here, and which Mr. Thorne would not deny to-day when he was seen at the Millbrook Hunt meet. He has a country home at Millbrook.

If Mr. Thorne enters himself in the lists for the nomination there is likely to be a lively contest between him and Hamilton Fish, who was defeated for reelection last Autumn by Richard Connell of this city.

Mr. Fish is quoted as saying that he wants another nomination and is willing to go to some length to get it.
